

Community Development and Environmental Protection

September 2011 - June 2012. Funded through Democracy Commission Small Grants Program, the U.S. Embassy in Georgia

The project aims to support environmental protection in Imereti Region municipalities through organizing civic education campaigns and community-based projects. After the project, completing 89 village trustees of Imereti Region and six municipalities will be trained and informed about different environmental protection activities.

- Through an information/education/communication campaign the population of project target communities will be informed about the separation of waste; preparation of organic manure and ways of how to produce bio products and new standards and norms of usage of fertilizers etc.
- Educational lessons on environmental protection for pupils will be organized in the target schools

In general, the population will increase their level of knowledge and skills how to protect environment and make their village or activities more attractive for tourists. The project will help them by providing different theoretical information and practical skills on modern ways of production of bio products in order to make their agro businesses more productive and have a positive financial impact on their business.
