

## **Inclusive Local government – How Local Authorities Create Inclusive Public Policy towards Marginalized Groups**

March - December 2010. Funded by Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, led by City of Bydgoszcz (Poland)

The main objective of the project was to assist representatives of Terjola local government in creating new programmes and strategies to prevent unemployment and facilitate social integration, involvement on the part of non-governmental organisations and cooperation with minorities. As part of the project, the local government in Bydgoszcz shared its experience from 20 years since the beginning of political transformation.

During project, implementation following activities were organized:

- A training session for Terjola Municipality representatives in the city of Bydgoszcz along with study visits to respective organizations and institutions working with marginalized groups
- A Polish-Georgian round table on prospect initiatives dedicated to inclusive public policy on local level
- A visit of Bydgoszcz delegation to Terjola
- A publication and dissemination campaign on results of the training along with good practices from local government in Bydgoszcz within the Georgian local governments undertaken by the ALDA office with cooperation of LDA Georgia
- A new project-proposal was developed and will be submitted to the Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the next call.
