Project Description:

Nowadays, state institutions try hard to adhere and observe the rights of human beings that are generally recognized, particularly, the women's rights. Protection of women's rights is conducted in the best ways using effective democracy policy from one side, and on the other side, with common acknowledgement and insurance of it.

That is why we feel expedient to make our contribution in establishing and forming fluency in general acknowledgement of human rights and freedoms in Georgia. This will give us opportunity to ensure and guarantee it, using democratic principles and policy, considering that it covers itself and is composed with rights of broad range.

Consequently, considering the problems of our town, we truly believe that on this stage, we should direct our attention to women's rights. According to Georgian Legislation, in the normative part of it, a woman and a man are equal. However, in practice we exercise cases, when a woman suffers from violence of a man. In this case, women's rights are not only humiliated but ignored as well. It is rather difficult to find a way out of a situation because of the some reasons. First: a woman does not possess the sufficient knowledge of her rights; second, there is lack of organic units that could help with consultations and support to protect her rights.

This project gives an opportunity to train and exercise local government and appropriately selected representatives for increasing their knowledge in women's rights and to be able to protect not only their own rights but in case of it's violation, to supply women with appropriate support and assistance.

Project aims:

- to introduce women's rights to project participants;
- to use legislative means in a case of violation of women's rights and how to restore it;
- to assist sufficiently (when needed) when others rights are violated.

Project Objectives:

- To conduct 12 training sessions with duration 1 day in Kutaisi
- To prepare and disseminate printed material
- To organize information campaign
- To develop manual for training participants
