### **Description of the project:**

Working out of joint state politic, inculcation of legal ethic and high quality of the state structures' working is very essential for the country in order to be developed as a legal state and forming of civil society in it.

All these mean training of a high-qualified staff in the country. Unfortunately there is no joint and effective mechanism for professional training of the students in the country. Especially it is important to support development of the students of law faculty as professionals and settling the problems in this sphere. In different high schools there is no ability of extending theoretical knowledge with practical works, as this question isn't paid much attention in the universities. In order to achieve the aforesaid it is very difficult for students of law faculty in Georgia and especially in the region. The reason of these difficulties is that they have no ability of getting innovations in legislation and don't have modern legal literature.

All these prevent development of the students as professional lawyers. Also, the students of different universities have no relationship in order to share their knowledge, experience and ideas to each other.

So, the project group set aim to organize one-year learning course for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year students of law faculty in Imereti region. The learning course covers 12 months, which is divided into 3 stages. The learning course implies teaching of women's rights. The students will be enrolled on the basis of competition, which will be held by judges. The number of enrolled students will be 40 and they will be divided into two groups. Information about competition will be available by our advertising campaign. The learning course consists of 3 stages and each one covers 4 months. On the first stage is taught women's rights and constitutional law, second- women's rights and civil law, third- women's rights and criminal law. The learning course includes theoretical as well as practical studies. In the first two months the students will be given theoretical materials by trainers and on other two months they will have practical works, where students will study legal skills. At the end of each stage the students will have tests according to learnt theoretical and practical materials. Also at the end of each stage the student will present two imitated trails according to case chosen beforehand by trainer. One group of the students will present imitated trails according to regulation foreseen by Georgian legislation and the other group – according to regulation foreseen by international legislation. After completing of the project the course of our lecture will be published as a book.
